BINATIONAL SUPPLIER DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM

Is an intensive binational program of up to 12 weeks designed to accelerate the growth of the manufacturing industry supply chain businesses on both sides of the border.

Its objective is to expand the participation of local companies as suppliers to large manufacturers in the Paso del Norte binational region.

In 2020, the 2nd and 3rd generation were carried out in a hybrid way, of which 22 companies graduated with PPAP and Grupo ROSA awarded the seed money prize of their respective generations.

FAB LAB PASO DEL NORTE



A national project of social intervention to strengthen skills and create economic opportunities for young people in vulnerable situations from Baja California, Coahuila, Mexico City , State of Mexico, Jalisco, Michoacán, Nuevo León and Chihuahua.

Fundación Axcel A. C. worked together with the Fundación del Empresariado Chihuahuense, AC (FECHAC) to provide training and technical tools to groups of young people. It was organized around the creation of Social Economy companies with the MAIEES Methodology of the Andalusian School of Social Economy and the Ibero Puebla.

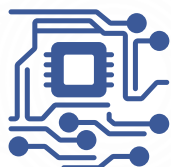
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FAB LAB EDU

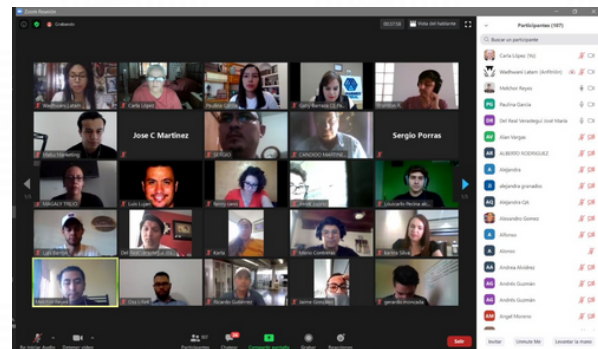


EMPRENDIMIENTOS WADWHANI

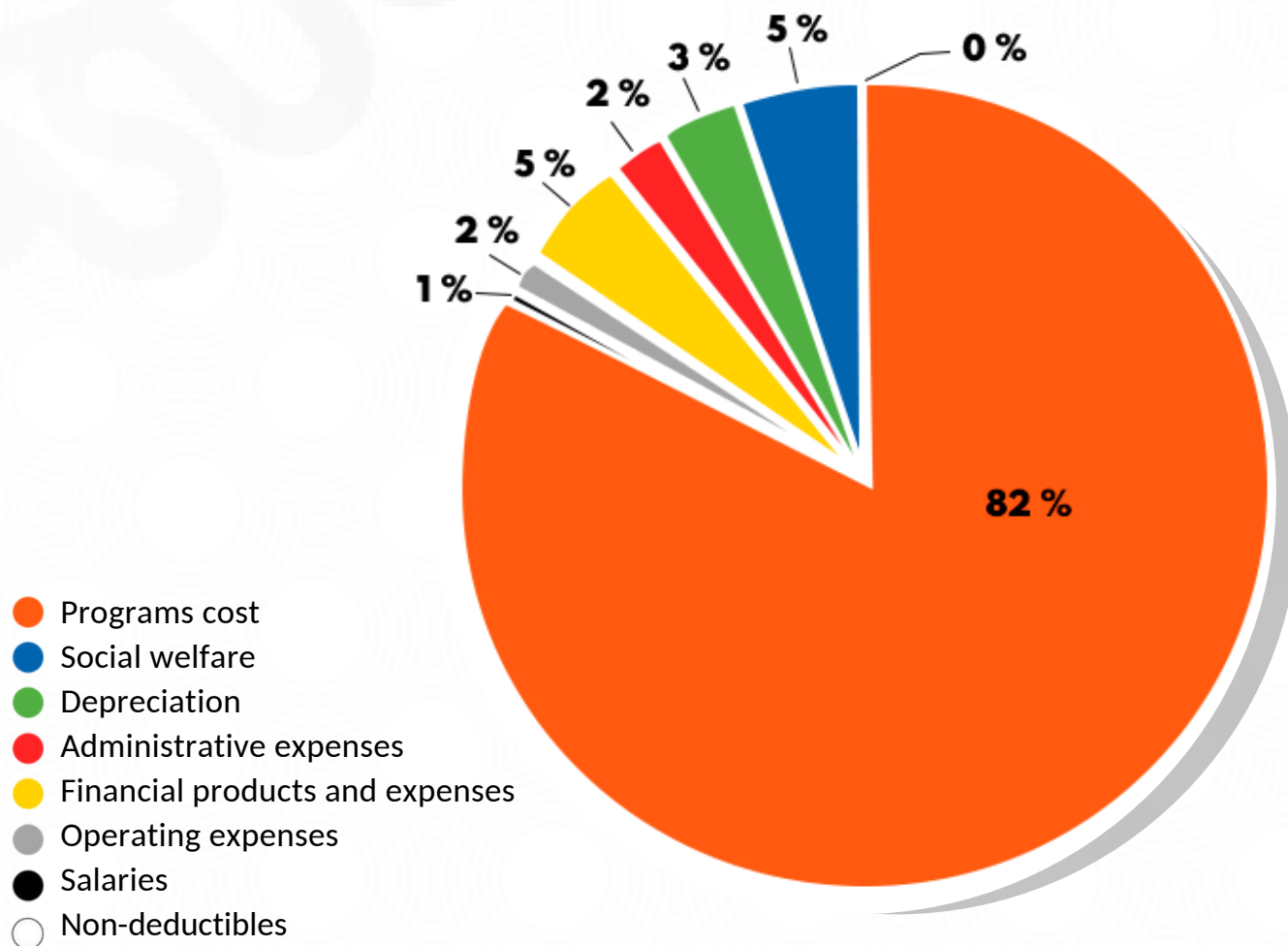
